We the People

Article 1

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted, shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
Section 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Electors in each State for six Years, and there shall be one Senator from each State in every second Year...
