Please be advised that your letter to the Lewis-Palmer School District, alleging violations of Colorado campaign finance law, in fact, states no such violation. It is not a violation of Colorado or federal law, for that matter, for members of groups, such as the local realtors' organization, the local firefighters' organization or other membership organizations, including the Lewis-Palmer Education Association, to communicate with their members or their members' families about political candidates. It is my understanding that the District's legal counsel has reviewed your allegations and has likewise concluded that there have been no violations of law on the part of the LPEA or of the District.

If you continue to believe that LPEA has done something wrong during this school board campaign, I suggest you contact an attorney who practices law in this area.
